Site Notices

The Applicant has prepared a notice of the Preliminary Meeting, Open Floor Hearing, and Issue Specific Hearing 1 in accordance with rule 13(6)-(10) of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended). This was provided to the Planning Inspectorate on 27 March 2026.

A copy of the notice has been uploaded to the project-specific website (www.tweenbridgesolar.co.uk). Notices were erected on site on Monday 30th March 2026 and are being periodically checked in the lead-up to the events.

Examination Timetable

The Applicant has reviewed the examination timetable and has no comments at this stage.

ExA Site Visit Itinerary

The Applicant has prepared a suggested Site Visit Itinerary for the ExA in accordance with Annex F of the Rule 6 Letter. A copy of the suggested itinerary is provided at Annex A of this letter.

The Applicant sent a draft itinerary to the host authorities (City of Doncaster Council and North Lincolnshire Council) for review and comment. The host authorities accepted the Applicant's itinerary and provided some additional suggestions, which have been added to the itinerary and are identified in blue text for ease of reference.

Procedural Decisions

Statements of Common Ground

The Applicant has drafted Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) with consultees in relation to the Scheme, as listed in Annex F of the Rule 6 Letter. In addition, the Applicant has prepared a SoCG with Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust. The Applicant has not prepared a SoCG with the relevant Fire and Rescue Services, as no Relevant Representations were submitted by those bodies. In the absence of any issues being raised or matters in dispute, the Applicant considers that there is no basis upon which to develop a SoCG for the purposes of the Examination. The Applicant will liaise with the Fire and Rescue Services to ascertain if they wish to pursue a SoCG.

The Applicant has issued the first drafts of the SoCG to stakeholders and invited comments back in advance of Deadline 1.

The working draft SoCGs will be submitted at Deadline 1 as requested.

Additional Submissions & Relevant Representations

The Applicant acknowledges the ExA's decision, outlined in Annex F of the Rule 6 Letter, to accept the additional submissions by the Applicant and the relevant representations submitted late. The Applicant has reviewed all the relevant representations and responses will be provided at Deadline 1, in accordance with the examination timetable provide in Annex D of the Rule 6 Letter.

Principal Issues

The Applicant has reviewed the initial assessment of the Principal Issues set out in Annex C of the Rule 6 Letter and are satisfied that it provides an appropriate and comprehensive overview of the key matters likely to arise during the Examination. We note, however, that



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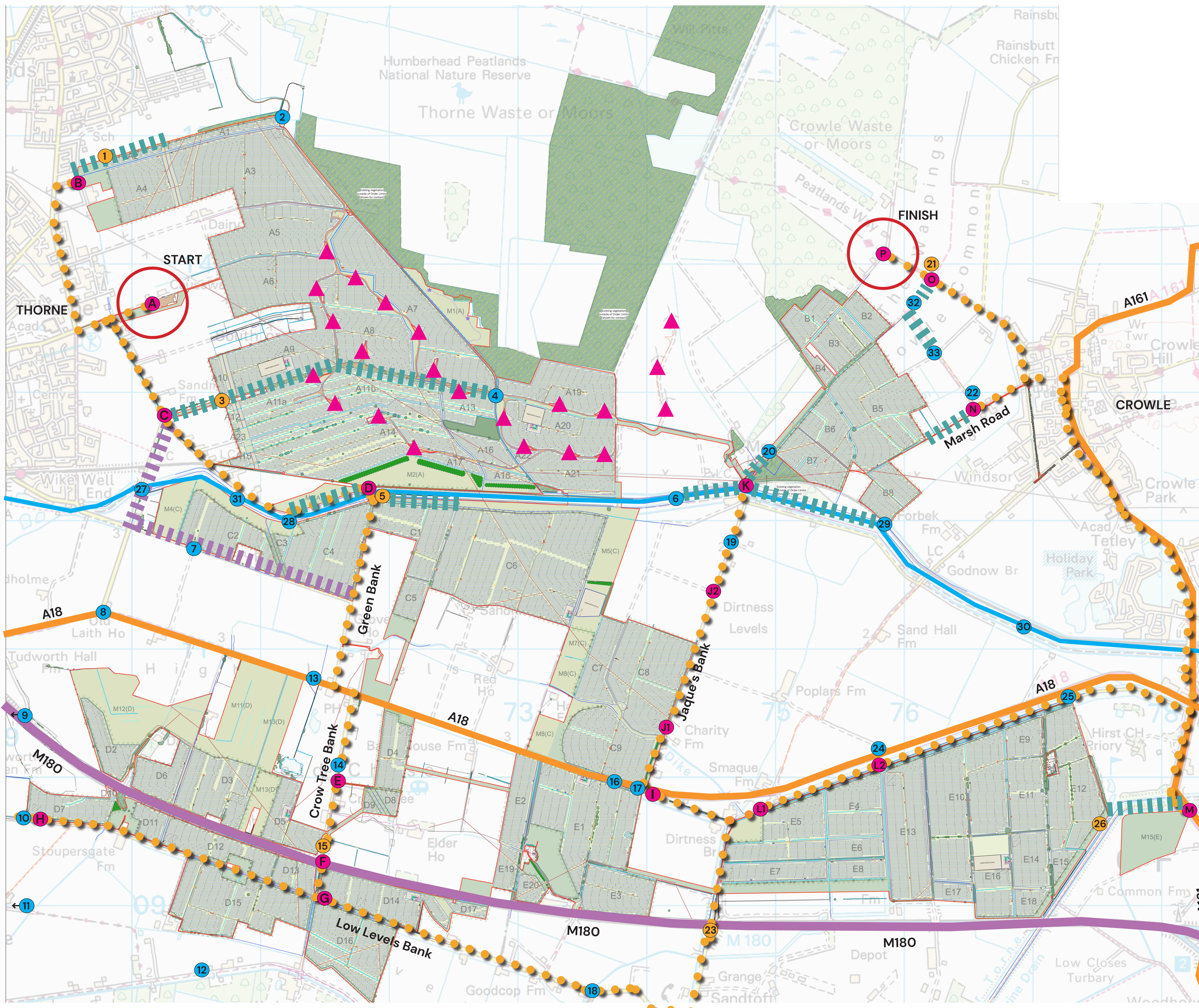
additional issues may emerge as the process progresses, and we anticipate that these will be addressed in the normal course of the Examination where relevant.

- A. Meet at Causeway Farm, DN8 5RY (///that.captures.attending)
- B. Drive to Wilkinson Avenue (///dragonfly fiery shade) and walk to start of public right of way (///overt hedgehog.harp) adjacent to the northern boundary
- C. From Moor Edges Road (///chilled.supporting shepherds), Drive or walk along Moor Owners Road/public right of way to the first wind turbine associated with Tween Bridge Wind Farm and pause, then continue to Viewpoint 4.
- D. Park at the junction of High Bridge Road and Green Bank adjacent to Stainforth and Keadby Canal. (///deployed.charts.trappings). Opportunity to walk along canal both to the east and west.
- E. Stop in entrance along Crow Tree Bank and look east (///iteration.standard.voting)
- F. Pause along Crow Tree Bank at bridge crossing of M180, observe extent of environmental mitigation areas M11, M12 & M13 to the north-west (///hype.manage.darts)
- G. Park close to junction of Crow Tree Bank and Low Levels Bank (///treatable.shunted.stapled) and observe Order Limits from road, walking along road as necessary.
- H. Drive along Low Levels Bank/Sandtoft Road and turn around at The Green Tree Inn car park (hobbit.iteration.section).
- I. Park in layby at junction of High Levels Bank and A18 (///unleashed.improvise.mooring) and observe either side of main road.
- J. (J1/J2) Drive up Jaque's Bank and stop to observe Order Limits, from select stopping points along the road. (///kitchens.relatives.spirit)
- K. Park in the vicinity of Crook O'Moor Bridge (///reheat.riper.converged) and subsequently walk to Viewpoints 6, 20 and 29 in turn. Return along Jaque's Bank.
- L. (L1/L2). Pause along minor road adjacent to pumping station (///spacing.procures.robots) and at field entrance points (///overlaps.loyal.samplers)
- M. Park off A161 adjacent to River Torne (///play.fetching longer) and walk along public right of way along opposing side of the A161 through the woodland until close to the Order Limits (///toward.divided.treaty)
