Thank you for your e-mail dated 30 April 2026 with the attached letter and enclosures of the same date. The letter notifies the Examining Authority (ExA) that the applicant intends to make various changes to the application.

The applicant considers that these do not amount to changes which trigger the need for a formal 'change request'. However, whilst it may be the case that the changes are not material (which will be determined at a later date), they would involve changes to the Land Plans and the Works Plans which are not simply the correction of errors. I consider that it would be advantageous for all parties if the change request was dealt with formally.

I therefore accept your letter dated 30 April 2026 as a formal notification of an intention to submit a change request.

It is understood that the applicant intends to submit the change request during week commencing 1 June 2026. This is acceptable on the basis that the applicant is undertaking what I consider to be a proportionate and appropriate consultation. All responses to that consultation should be provided with the change request.
