## **The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 – Rule 9 and Rule 17**

### **Application by RWE Renewables UK Solar and Storage Limited for an order granting development consent for the Tween Bridge Solar Farm Project: Amended plans, closing statements and unaccompanied site inspections**

I am writing to you under rule 9 and 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010.

#### **Amended plans**

I have made a procedural decision under rule 9 to accept the following plans:

- Environmental Statement Figure 2.2a Indicative Operational Layout Plan (Fixed Solar Panels) (Rev 3) [REP4-038].
- Environmental Statement Figure 2.2b Indicative Operational Layout Plan (Fixed and Tracker Solar Panels) (Rev 3) [REP4-039].

These plans were submitted at deadline 4 by the applicant and an explanation of their purpose and the effects on the proposed development is included in the applicant's covering letter [REP4-001].

In summary the plans include the following amendments:

- Removal of solar panels from fields E19 and E20.
- Spatial refinement of 132 kilovolt (kV) substation and 100 megawatt (MW) battery energy storage system (BESS) within Flood Zone 3b.
- Reconfiguration of solar panels within field E15.

I agree with the applicant that these amendments do not materially alter the proposed development as originally applied for. This is because: the plans are both indicative; they

both aim to reduce the effects of the proposed development; and the amendments fall within the flexible Rochdale envelope approach adopted by the applicant in undertaking its Environmental Impact Assessment. In addition, there is sufficient time remaining in the examination for you to make representations in relation to these plans, as set out in question Q3.1.3 of my third round of written questions.

### **Closing statements**

I am making a formal request for closing statements from the applicant, North Lincolnshire Council and City of Doncaster Council under rule 17. These should be submitted at deadline 8.

### **Unaccompanied site inspections (USI)**

I have now undertaken two USIs as follows:

- USI1: 13 April 2026.
- USI2: 06 August 2026.
