

Points relating to the ExA questions ExQ1

Q1.11.4 – raises the point that noise impacts have not been assessed because of the proposed distance between PRow and equipment. The construction compound north of the village of Scopwick is proposed to be sited adjacent to the spires and steeples footpath. The noise, dust, danger, visual impact and any other impacts should be considered the applicant. A written report of these effects should be submitted and reviewed by the ExA.

Q1.15.2 – the effect of the breakdown of underground cables over time and the toxins leaching out of them should be included in considerations for leaving cables in the ground. It is my view they are only being left in because it is cheaper than removing them, not better for the environment.
