Also to add that shift patterns will be agreed with the local authorities to avoid workers using the A15/B1202 junction during embargo periods.	D3
3	LCC	Provide detailed response for how movements of vehicles during the proposed embargo periods at the A15/B1202 junction could be controlled/enforced.	D3
4	Applicant	Respond to question regarding whether the wording for highway agreement with LCC, routeing and movement numbers should be in a requirement or the oCTMP with reference to the precedent set in the Sherringham and Dudgeon Development Consent Order.	D3
5	Applicant	Provide updated cumulative traffic modelling to include the proposed National Grid Navenby Substation following scoping opinion being issued.	D3
6	Applicant	Revision of cumulative assessment to include Navenby BESS and Leoda, along with any other relevant developments at the time.	D4
