I am writing on behalf of the Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust (LWT) to request that we be considered as an interested party in the examination stage of Beacon Fen Energy Park.

LWT engaged with the non-statutory consultation for Beacon Fen Energy Park, where we provided advice to the Applicant on Biodiversity Net Gain, ground-nesting birds, habitat connectivity and enhancement, and the cumulative effects of solar projects of this nature. This advice was acknowledged by the Applicant in Table 7.1 of Chapter 7: Ecology (Environmental Statement), which records LWT's comments alongside a summary of outcomes. From this, we believe it is clear that LWT has made meaningful contributions to the application process to date.

Unfortunately, due to staff changes within the Trust, we did not meet the deadline to register as an interested party for the examination period. We apologise for this oversight, but respectfully request that, in light of LWT's prior contributions to the planning process and the Applicant's acknowledgement of our input, the Trust be granted interested party status for the examination stage of this project.
