

# Application by Beacon Fen Energy Park Limited for an order granting development consent for the Beacon Fen Energy Park Project

Case reference: EN010151

## Examining Authority's note of Access Required Site Inspection (ARSI) to which the application relates

Examining Inspector Andre Pinto, the person appointed as the Examining Authority (ExA) for the application for an order granting development consent for the Beacon Fen Energy Park Project, undertook the inspection on 14 November 2025, on either an unaccompanied or access required basis, accompanied by a member of the planning inspectorate's case team.

The inspection was undertaken by car and on foot on public accessible land and on private land where advanced permission to enter was granted, including highways and public rights of way.

A route was planned based on the applicant's Draft itinerary for an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) [REP1-031] which also included site suggestions put forward by Lincolnshire County Council (LCC) and North Kesteven District Council (NKDC). Following a review of the information submitted in relation to a site inspection, the ExA decided to carry a site inspection on an access required basis.

Further site inspections may be required. Any future site inspections will be at the discretion of the ExA.

#### Particulars of the ARSI

The inspection was undertaken by the ExA on an unaccompanied and a access required basis. ARSI was carried out on the 14 November 2025.

### Day 1: 14 November

Weather: Rainy, with periods of heavy rain and overcast for most of the day. Reasonable visibility at all times.

The Inspection commenced at 10:00 and concluded at approximately 14:45. The ExA approached the first stop of the ARSI travelling by car, eastbound, from Evedon to Ewerby Thorpe, via Ewerby.

The table below indicates the sites that were visited on the 14 November by the ExA.
