Dear Sirs,

We write to confirm that the Applicant has included Protective Provisions for the benefit of National Grid Electricity Transmission in the final DCO at Deadline 8. These are agreed.

The parties were however intending to conclude a side agreement to then enable NGET to withdraw their relevant representation to the Order. Whilst the documentation was fully agreed and in a final format on 11th February 2026 and executed by NGET on 12th February, the Applicant has not been able to execute the documentation within this timescale and we understand that they are doing this as soon as their internal processes allow.

Accordingly NGET are writing to notify PINS that this agreed side agreement is outstanding but that once the Applicant has executed and dated the agreement, NGET will then write to PINS to confirm the withdrawal of their relevant representation. We will provide a further update in this respect as soon as we are able to do so.
