Morning

I just wanted to follow up on the below and ask whether you anticipated CDC providing comments on the DRAFT Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC) for Fenwick Solar Farm?

I also wanted to raise one proposed change from the version of the SoCC previously shared. We are proposing changing the local newspaper we use for the statutory publicity (para 4.5.2) of the SoCC to the *Doncaster Free Press*, rather than the *Yorkshire Post*. We note that CDC suggested *Doncaster Free Press* in earlier comments on the SoCC and having reviewed further we recognise the more localised focus near to the proposals that the *Doncaster Free Press* provides.

We would still intend to send a press release to the *Yorkshire Post.* As *Doncaster Free Press* publishes on a Thursday, this would also have the effect of moving our consultation date by one day (17 April to 18 April).

Could you confirm whether this change would be acceptable to CDC, or let me know any queries?

I'd be happy to discuss this, or any other aspects of our approach, further if helpful.
