

City of Doncaster Council would suggest that site inspections are undertaken from the following locations, in all cases to assist the consideration of landscape and visual impacts of the proposed development, also in respect of landscape features including hedgerows and public rights of way (PRoW):

- Fenwick and its local PRoW network, as well as the road running east to Haggs Farm and Riddings Farm, up to Fenwick Hall, and the loop road south to Common Lane, and the PRoW running north (east of the railway)
- West End and associated PRoW – and proposed diversion
- Jett Hall and associated PRoW
- Topham and associated Trans Pennine Trail – National Route
- River Went and the PRoW along it from Topham Ferry Bridge
- Chapel Hill, Lowgate Road, Cherry Tree Farm-Lowgate Farm – Linton House Farm area
- PRoW east of Moss – the main access, and up to the site of the BESS and Substation including the PRoW in these areas
- Elevated view from Askern – high point near Swan Court
- The route of the grid connection and access route from the south near Barnby Dun.

A map can be provided to support this information if this would assist the Examining Authority.
