- Plate 12: View south across wildfowling land from the flood bank (Asset 258) adjacent to the Weaver (the northern Site boundary).

- Plate 17: View south along the western side of the wildfowling land east of Brook Furlong, with the eastern face of the bank around Cell 1 on the right; the reeds and small trees on the left mark the position of the sewage outfall (Asset 270).
- Plate 18: View east along the southern edge of Cell 1, showing the bank around Cell 5 to the south of the track.
- Plate 19: View west across the interior of Cell 2 from its SE corner, with the bank along the northern edge of Cell 5 to the south (left), looking towards the turbines of the Western Cluster.
- Plate 20: View north across Cell 1 from the track along its southern boundary, looking towards Weston with surface pipes crossing the cell E-W in the middle distance.

- Plate 21: View NE across uneven ground and ponds in the northwestern corner of Cell 1, showing two probable ventilation shafts (Asset 316) (a third is visible on the left hand edge).
- Plate 22: Probable ventilation shafts located on the eastern edge of Cell 2, viewed from the track to Marsh Farm, looking southwest.


