### Thanks for your email.

I can confirm that Frodsham Solar is not an offshore development and does not include any works within any of the areas defined in section 42(2) of the Planning Act 2008, as such there was not a statutory requirement to consult with the MMO. On this basis we didn't place notices in the Lloyds List or an appropriate fishing journal. This position is set out at paragraph 8.8.2 of the Consultation Report [EN010153/DR/5.1].

Nevertheless, as we discussed the proposals with the MMO early in the project development, we did include them as a consultee in our statutory consultation process. They did not provide any response to the consultation.
