The following locations are suggested for an accompanied site inspection:

- a) Fishing Pools (Cell3) as shown on Fig 4 of AS-017 5.3 Information to Inform HRA
- b) Northern end of Cell 1 (and embankment to River Weaver) as shown on Fig 4 of AS-017 5.3 Information to Inform HRA

The reason for the above recommended locations for an accompanied site visit is that the northern sides of these cells are not currently accessible publicly. Cell 1 is proposed to provide one of the new



permissive paths, and the relationship with the River Weaver and Manchester Ship Canal should be viewed. Whilst Cell 3 can be viewed from the public right of way along the southern boundary, appreciation of the relationship of Cell 3 with the Fishing Pools and the Mersey Estuary SSSI would be best obtained from a visit along the northern embankment, by obtaining access via Frodsham Marsh Farm.
