I write on behalf of Frodsham Solar Ltd (the “Applicant”) in response to the Examining Authority’s (ExA’s) letter dated 16 December 2025 (‘Rule 8 letter’) in respect of Examination Deadline 1. This letter sets out the submissions made by the Applicant for Deadline 1.

The Applicant note that the changes to the application documents above do not take into account the ExA's first written questions. These will be taken forward at future deadlines.

The Applicant also notes that a SoCG with Cadent is not submitted, as suggested in the Rule 8 Letter, for the reasons given in the **Written Summary of Applicant's Oral Submissions at Issue Specific Hearing 1 (ISH1), and Post Hearing Notes**.

Changes in National Policy

National Policy Statements for Energy

As the Applicant noted in their Procedural Deadline B Response Letter (PD2-025), the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero announced on 13th November 2025 the consultation outcome of the proposed revisions to National Policy Statements EN-1, EN-3 and EN-5, which were published for consultation on 24 April 2025. The government has confirmed that it intends to proceed with the proposed updates to the NPSs, with some amendments, and the National Policy Statements are expected to be designated before the end of January 2025.

In light of this, the Applicant has provided a **Note on updated National Policy Statements EN-1, EN-3, and EN-5 [EN010153/DR/8.15]** alongside this submission. This confirms that the Proposed Development should be determined in accordance with the 2024 NPSs as the application was accepted for examination prior to publication of the updated 2025 NPSs. The 2025 NPSs may therefore be an important and relevant consideration, but are not the primary reference for decision-making. The changes introduced by the updated 2025 NPSs reinforce the Government's focus on the need for new renewable and low carbon energy infrastructure to achieve the Clean Power 2030 Mission. The updates and amendments to the NPSs would have little material impact on the decision-making for the Proposed Development.

National Planning Policy Framework


Government began a consultation on an updated National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) on 16th December 2025, with the consultation scheduled to close on 10th March 2026. On this basis, it would appear unlikely that the final NPPF will be published prior to the close of examination on 30th April 2026.

Government has set out on page 106 of the consultation document¹ in relation to the transitional arrangements that *"It is proposed that the Framework would be a material consideration from the day of publication of the final version"*. At this time, the draft updated NPPF is therefore not a material consideration.

It is likely that the final published version of the revised NPPF will undergo further significant changes from the consultation version, given the level of changes from the current NPPF and the nature of the questions being asked by Government through the consultation. The Applicant therefore believes there is limited value to the examination at this stage in providing commentary on the implications of the draft revised NPPF when the current published version is not a material consideration. The Applicant proposes to provide a note on the revised NPPF should it be published in final form prior to the close of examination, but welcomes the ExA's view on this matter.
