

The Proposed Development comprises the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of a solar photovoltaic (PV) electricity generating facility with on-site Battery Energy Storage System and other associated infrastructure, with a total capacity exceeding 50 megawatts (MW), along with an import and export connection via the national transmission network at the proposed National Grid substation near Navenby. The site of the Proposed Development is located approximately 9km south and south west of Lincoln in proximity to the villages of Thorpe on the Hill, Witham St Hughs, Haddington, Thurlby, Navenby, and Bassingham.

The deadline date for all representations to be received by the Secretary of State under section 56 was 11:59pm on 27 October 2025 except for the three parties listed in the Schedule to this certificate in relation to whom the original notification was not received and an extended deadline of 11:59pm on 21 November 2025 was set.
