NOTIFICATION OF HEARINGS RELATING TO FOSSE GREEN ENERGY

Notice is hereby given that the following Hearings will be held by the Examining Authority for the examination of the application made by Fosse Green Energy Limited (Company No 13438725) (the **Applicant**) of 22 Grosvenor Gardens, London, United Kingdom, SW1W 0DH for a Development Consent Order ("**DCO**") under sections 14, 15 and 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the **Application**). The Applicant is a partnership between Windel Energy Ltd (Company No 11650112) and Recurrent Energy.

The Application was made to the Secretary of State (via the Planning Inspectorate) on 18 July 2025 and was accepted for examination on 15 August 2025. The Application has been given the Planning Inspectorate reference number EN010154.

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

The Application seeks development consent for Fosse Green Energy approximately 9km south and south west of Lincoln in proximity to the villages of Thorpe on the Hill, Witham St Hughs, Haddington, Thurlby, Navenby and Bassingham, and is located within the administrative areas of North Kesteven District Council and Lincolnshire City Council ("the **Proposed Development**"). The Proposed Development comprises the construction, operation, maintenance and decommission of a solar photovoltaic (PV) electricity generating facility with a capacity of over 50 megawatts (MW) and export connection to the National Grid.

The Proposed Development covers a total area of approximately 1,355 hectares (ha) and comprises the principal site and cable corridor. The principal site is the area of the Proposed Development covered by the ground-mounted solar PV generating station including PV modules fitted to mounting structures, Solar Stations, Battery Energy Storage System (BESS), Onsite Substation, planting and mitigation areas, interconnecting cables between solar PV areas, and associated infrastructure. The cable corridor is the area of the Proposed Development in which the 400 kilovolt (kV) and associated cables (the Grid Connection Cables) will be installed to facilitate connection between the Onsite Substation and the proposed National Grid substation near Navenby.

The DCO, if granted, would authorise the compulsory acquisition of land, interests in land and rights over land and the powers to use land permanently and temporarily, for the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of the Proposed Development. The DCO would also make provisions in connection with several ancillary matters, including the construction of permanent alterations to the layout of streets, the construction of accesses to the Proposed Development, the alteration, diversion, stopping up or management of public rights of way, street works, removal of hedgerows and the modification and disapplication of relevant legislation.
