

**Application by Fosse Green Energy Limited for an order granting development consent for the proposed Fosse Green Energy**

Speakers will be heard in the order shown under the List of Speakers in **Annex A**:

- The following **maximum** speaking times will be applied:
  - A maximum speaking time of five minutes per person will apply to oral submissions made by individual IPs; and
  - A maximum speaking time of ten minutes will apply to oral submissions made by organisations, groups or representatives of a number of IPs or other persons
  - Speakers should avoid repeating what a previous speaker has said and instead indicate that they agree with what an earlier speaker has said
- Each IP who has registered to speak will be invited forward in turn to speak at a table set up in front of the Examining Authority (ExA), or via Microsoft Teams if attending online.

- Each 'other person' (non-IP) who has registered to speak will then, at the ExA's discretion and if time permits, be invited forward in turn to speak.
- The ExA may ask questions of persons and the applicant about matters arising from the oral submissions. The applicant will also have the opportunity to respond to matters raised by IPs or other persons.

#### **4. Review of matters and actions arising**

The ExA will review how any actions arising from the discussion during the hearing are to be addressed by the applicant, other IPs or other persons. A written action list will be published by the ExA (if required).

#### **5. Close of hearing**

##### **Purpose of the open floor hearing (OFH)**

The purpose of the hearing is to give IPs an opportunity to make oral representations about the application. The hearing is subject to the powers of control of the ExA, as set out in the Planning Act 2008 (PA2008) and supporting legislation. The ExA will invite parties to speak and may ask questions as it considers necessary. All comments, questions and answers are to be directed to the ExA and not directly to any other party.

Oral submissions made in an OFH should be based on representations previously made in writing, **but they should not simply repeat matters previously covered in the written submission**. Rather, submissions made in an OFH should focus on specific detail and explanation to help inform the ExA. There should be no new or unexpected material in oral representations. A written summary note with any supporting evidence or references will be requested from each speaker following an OFH.

IPs and other persons intending to participate in OFH1 are reminded of the advice the ExA gave under the first item in Annex F of the Rule 6 letter it issued on 9 December 2025 [[PD-008](#)] concerning ethical procurement. IPs and other persons participating in OFH1 are encouraged to restrict their submissions about the proposed development to its effects on the land it would occupy and/or the area within the vicinity of that land.

##### **Attendees**

The event will be livestreamed and a link for watching the livestream will be posted on the [project website](#) closer to the hearing date. IPs and members of the public who wish to observe the hearing can therefore view and listen to the hearing using the livestream, or view and listen to the recording, after it has concluded.

## **Timing**

The ExA will keep to the agenda as much as possible. The hearing is not expected to go beyond 19:30.

Anyone who is not able to provide all their oral submissions by the close of the hearing should follow it up in writing.

## **Registration Process**

Parties who have registered to speak (both in person and virtually) will receive a Joining Instruction email shortly before the hearing which will include a link to the virtual event on Microsoft Teams, and a telephone number should they need to participate by telephone. To enable the hearing to start on time at **17.00** those attending virtually should join promptly at **16.30** to ensure that all virtual attendees can complete the Registration Process in good time.
