Thank you for providing a draft Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) relating to the above development on 12 December 2025. Where possible we prefer to provide comments in the form of a letter rather than a SoCG. ***Please note that we request views from the Office for Health Improvement and Disparities (OHID) and the response provided below is sent on behalf of both UKHSA and OHID***

We have reviewed your comments against our recommendations submitted at Deadline 3A. The SoCG (EN010154/EXAM/8.15) sets out our position against each of the points.

Please accept this as a covering letter to confirm UKHSA agreement with the Statement of Common Ground as outlined in email 19/03/2026, given that UKHSA does not sign third party SoCGs.
