## Planning Act 2008 – section 102A

### Application by Fosse Green Energy Limited for an order granting development consent for the Fosse Green Energy project

#### Request to become interested parties

We refer to the request, dated 28 April 2026, for Phillips 66 Limited (P66) to become an interested party under section (s) 102A of the Planning Act 2008 (PA2008) [[REP5-035](#)]. That request to become an interested party being in respect of the land within the proposed Order Limits that Prax Downstream UK Limited (in liquidation) and Prax Lindsey Oil Refinery Limited (in liquidation) (Prax) had an interest in up until 28 April 2028 when P66 completed the purchase of Prax's interests.

Given the change of landownership with respect to part of the proposed Order Limits that arose on 28 April 2028, the Examining Authority (ExA) considers that P66 should be treated as having become an interested party under s102(A) of the PA 2008, in effect inheriting the examination status previously held by Prax. That is because P66 has become a person within Categories 1 and/or 2 for the purposes of s102B of PA2008.

This letter therefore notifies you that Phillips 66 Limited has become an interested party under s102(1)(ab) PA2008 from today's date. The unique reference number is **FGES-003**. Please ensure you quote that number in any future correspondence.
