The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 – rule 17

Application by Fosse Green Energy Limited for an order granting development consent for the Fosse Green Energy

Request for further information

We are writing under rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 further to our asking of ExQ3 GC.3.03 (proposed Navenby substation) and your response to that written question included in [REP5A-052]. In your response to ExQ3 GC.3.03 you advised that a planning application for the proposed substation had been submitted on 1 May 2026 and that as of 12 May (Deadline 5A) the planning application was awaiting validation by North Kesteven District Council (NKDC). In [AS-139] NKDC confirmed that the submitted planning application had not been registered because additional documentation had been requested by it.

As part of ExQ3 GC.3.03 we requested the submission of copies of: the site location ('red line') plan; a block plan; and elevational drawings for the proposed substation in the event of a submitted planning application being registered by Deadline 5A. We requested that drawn material to assist our consideration of the proposed solar farm's cumulative effects.

The Examining Authority continues to be of the view that the previously requested drawn information would assist its consideration of the proposed solar farm's cumulative effects. Notwithstanding the fact that the planning application for the proposed substation has not been validated, given the examination for the proposed solar farm is drawing to its conclusion, we request that you submit copies of: the site location plan; a block plan; and elevational drawings for the proposed substation for information purposes so that we have a better understanding of what you are proposing and how those proposals would relate to the proposed solar farm when we are preparing our recommendation report for the Secretary of State's consideration. In making this request we recognise that there is potential for the details shown on the requested drawings to be revised as part of the

validation procedure for the submitted planning application or when the planning application is subsequently being considered by NKDC.

The requested drawings should be submitted no later than examination **Deadline 7** (9 June 2026).
