Fosse Green Energy Development Consent Order – Deadline 8 Submissions

Planning Inspectorate Case Reference: EN010154

We write on behalf of Fosse Green Energy Limited (the Applicant) further to the publication of the Rule 6 Letter **[PD-008]** on 9 December 2025, the Rule 8 Letter **[PD-010]** on 14 January 2026, the Revised Timetable **[PD-020]** on 8 April 2026 and the variation of the Examination Timetable **[PD-033]** on 17 June 2026 to provide the Applicant's written submissions for Deadline 8 of the Fosse Green Energy Development Consent Order (DCO) Examination (the Examination).

Submissions made at Deadline 8

Appendix 1 of this letter provides an overview of the documents submitted by the Applicant at this Deadline. Table 1 of Appendix 1 comprises the application documents for which updated versions are being submitted and provides brief reasoning as to why each document has been updated. Each of these updated documents has been submitted in both clean and tracked change versions to aid the Examining Authority (the ExA) in identifying the changes made.

Table 2 of Appendix 1 comprises the new document being submitted to the Examination.

Response to Rule 17 Request

The Applicant notes the content of the ExA's letter dated 17 June 2026, including a request for further information under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (Rule 17 Request). The Applicant's response to the Rule 17 Request has been submitted at this Deadline **[EN010154/EXAM/9.40]**.

As set out in detail in the Applicant's response, the updated flood mapping does not materially affect any existing application documents, whereby the findings and conclusions presented in the Flood Risk Assessment **[REP3-012]**, as well as the mitigation secured in the Framework Operational Environmental Management Plan

[REP7-017] (ref. WAT-O1), remain valid. Similarly, the review does not identify any need for changes to the Framework Surface Water Drainage Strategy **[REP7-014]**, which remains appropriate to manage surface water on the Proposed Development in light of the updated mapping. Further, the updated mapping does not result in any new, or changes to, effects established within the Environmental Statement (ES), and as such the Applicant does not propose to update any ES documents. Finally, it is also noted that the updated mapping does not affect the agreement reached with the Environment Agency with regards to flood risk and drainage, whereby the Applicant's and Environment Agency's positions set out in the Statement of Commonality **[REP7-034]** (which note all items as 'Agreed') remain valid.

Updates to the Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought

As of Deadline 7 (9 June 2026), the Applicant had entered into voluntary option agreements with the freehold owners of the land required for the Solar PV and BESS infrastructure within the Principal Site and was in the process of finalising an option agreement with the remaining freehold owner for the Principal Site in respect of land required for the 33 kV interconnecting cables, which will also be utilised for the delivery of biodiversity net gain.

The final option agreement was signed on 23 June 2026, and the Applicant is therefore pleased to confirm that it has entered into voluntary option agreements with all freehold owners for the land within the Principal Site. Accordingly, the Applicant has submitted an updated Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought **[EN010154/EXAM/9.6]** at this Deadline. The updated Schedule of Negotiations and Powers Sought also reflects that on 15 June 2026 the Applicant and Phillips 66 Limited reached agreement on the final form of protective provisions for the benefit of Phillips 66 Limited included at Part 9 of Schedule 14 to the draft DCO **[AS-144]** as set out in the Applicant's Cover Letter dated 15 June 2026 **[AS-141]**.

Additional Affected Parties

As set out in the Applicant's Deadline 7 Cover Letter **[REP7-001]**, the Applicant had identified an additional party with a potential interest in land within the Order Limits (Noventum Power Solar 4 Limited) and a party which already had interests within the Order Limits had acquired the freehold title of an additional land interest (Benjamin Howard Wray). The Applicant has been in correspondence with Benjamin Wray who has confirmed that he does not wish to make any submissions. A copy of this correspondence is attached provided at Appendix 2. The Applicant understands that Benjamin Wray intends to provide confirmation of the same directly to the ExA.

The Applicant notes the ExA's confirmation that Noventum Power Solar 4 Limited (Noventum) has become an interested party under s102(1)(ab) of the Planning Act 2008 as of 25 June 2026. In requesting interested party status, Noventum indicated that it would submit representations at Deadline 8 (30 June 2026). The Applicant had a meeting with Noventum on 25 June 2026 to discuss the overlap and will at Deadline 9 (6 July 2026) provide its response to any representations made by Noventum at Deadline 8 in accordance with the varied Examination Timetable **[PD-033]**.
