- Solar PV panels;
- Solar PV array mounting structures;
- Power Conversion System ('PCS') in the form of inverters and transformers;
- Grid Connection Infrastructure comprising Customer and DNO Substation buildings and external electrical equipment and ancillary infrastructure within a security fence;
- Perimeter fencing, gates, CCTV cameras, electrical cabling, and other associated infrastructure;
- Access from the highway and internal access tracks;
- Green Infrastructure including landscape planting and ecological enhancements.

The deadline date for all representations to be received by the Commission (Secretary of State) under s.56 was 23:59 on 19 June 2025.

(Completed certificate to be received by the Secretary of State no later than 10 working days after the deadline date stating the applicant has fulfilled all of the requirements at (a), (b) and (c) above.
