1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 This Applicant's draft itinerary for the Accompanied Site Inspection ('draft itinerary') has been produced for FVS Dean Moor Limited (the 'Applicant') to support the DCO application for the Dean Moor Solar Farm ('the Proposed Development') on approximately 279.50ha of land located between the villages of Gilgarran and Branthwaite in West Cumbria (the 'Site'), which is situated within the administrative area of Cumberland Council ('the Council').
- 1.1.2 This document is provided to set out the locations the Applicant suggests the Examining Authority (ExA) visit during the Accompanied Site Inspection ('ASI'). The ExA requested that this document be submitted by Deadline 2.
- 1.1.3 The Applicant submitted its draft proposals for the ASI at Deadline 1 in its cover letter [REP1-001]. Although no other party suggested locations for the ASI, the Applicant had already discussed proposed locations with Cumberland Council and the Lake District National Park Authority.

2 Background

2.1 Rule 13 letter

- 2.1.1 The Rule 13 letter dated 19 August 2025 confirms that the ASI will take place on 18 September 2025 at 9:30am.
- 2.1.2 In producing the draft itinerary, the Applicant has been mindful of the ExA's comments in the Rule 13 letter:

It would assist me if the ASI draft itinerary, to be submitted by the applicant by deadline 2, Tuesday 26 August 2025, refined table 1 by setting out which of the viewpoints identified could be inspected on an unaccompanied basis. In addition, I would find it helpful if the ASI draft itinerary included further detail and focus on the site and its immediate environs, including locations of proposed permissive paths, features of ecological interest (including Dean Moor county wildlife site), highway access points, and general views of proposed 'area A, area B, area C, area D'.

2.1.3 The Applicant has therefore refined its Deadline 1 proposals, and these are set out in Chapter 3 below. Details of which viewpoints (identified at Deadline 1) could be inspected on an unaccompanied basis are set out in Table 1 below:

2.2 Health and Safety Information

- 2.2.1 The inspection will involve walking on some uneven or possibly wet ground and in proximity to vegetation. Attendees are recommended to wear appropriate sturdy footwear and weather appropriate clothing.
- 2.2.2 The ASI will also be taking place on highways adjacent to the Site. The Applicant will provide unbranded protective equipment for individuals who wish to attend without their own.
