

Has the developer considered, or made provision to attenuate, the increased rate of rainfall run off which will be experienced by the installation of Solar Panels and associated Ancillary Equipment on Dean Moor?

Rainfall Run Off from Dean Moor enters Lostrigg Beck which passes through my Property and also the Properties of my neighbours. An increased rate of rainfall run off from the development has the potential to cause flash flooding in Lostrigg Beck and cause damage to bridges and culverts which, as the sole means of access to the Properties in question, would cause serious disruption to our everyday lives.

What assurances can the developer provide that should this concern be realised there would be funding available to reinstate the access structures crossing Lostrigg Beck?
