3. Statements of Common Ground (SoCGs)

The Applicant can confirm that all SoCGs have been finalised with consultees and signed off. The Applicant is grateful to all consultees for their advice and engagement, and is pleased that all matters have now been agreed within every SoCG.

Since the previous iterations submitted at D4, the Applicant has agreed the remaining outstanding matters with the Council related to employment and skills, and the potential need for further engagement relating to temporary possession or acquisition rights.

The Applicant has engaged with consultees such as HE on the topics discussed at the ISH in relation to the gradation of effects, the LDNPA with respect to the Rule 17 letter dated 18 November 2025, and the EA in response to the matter highlighted by the ExA with respect of the contamination matter previously raised by the EA. However, it was agreed with these consultees that these discussions do not necessitate any changes to the SoCGs.

All SoCGs have been formally signed by both parties.
