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1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of this Document

- 1.1.1 This document has been prepared to record updates to the following Application Documents submitted as part of the Development Consent Order (DCO) Application for Peartree Hill Solar Farm ('the Proposed Development') in February 2025:
 - Environmental Statement (ES) Volume 1 and Volume 2 (Chapters 0 to 15) [APP-036] to [APP-051];
 - ES Volume 3 (Figures) [APP-052] to [APP-093]; and
 - ES Volume 4 (Non-Technical Summary, Commitments Register and Appendices) [APP-094] to [APP-144].
- 1.1.2 It is intended that this document remains a live document throughout the Examination and would be used to track updates and amendments to the ES. Further amendments or points of clarification which arise through Issue Specific Hearings, Written Representations, Written Questions or other relevant elements of the Examination process, would also be incorporated into this document accordingly.
- 1.1.3 This document will be updated and re-submitted for each of the Examination Deadlines, where necessary.

1.2 Document Structure

- 1.2.1 Section 2 of this document details the updates to ES Volumes 1 and 2 [APP-036] to [APP-051] since the DCO Application submission and sets out amendments within Table 2-1 to Table 2-78.
