Amendment to the appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on 23 October 2025. On 30 October 2025 a document was published confirming that Helena Obremski (Lead) and Mark James had been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application for the Rosefield Solar Farm project. These appointments were made in accordance with the Planning Inspectorate's Conflict of Interest Policy.

Helena Obremski has submitted her resignation from the panel under section 66(3) of the Planning Act 2008 (PA2008) due to personal reasons.

The Planning Inspectorate has considered the skill sets required for the panel members and has decided, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to appoint Richard Morgan as the replacement member of the panel, in the role of lead member, under section 69 of the PA2008, with effect from 27 January 2026.
