

I'm extremely concerned about the destruction of agricultural land and the decimation of the wild life in the proposed area. Also the increase in traffic in an area that is already stretched, the roads are already safety hazard with sharp bends, no pavements and narrow lanes. The local country lanes are not designed for large lorries and the whole area could easily be gridlocked. The local roads surfaces are already in extremely poor condition, add god knows how many huge lorries to that and they will be unusable. Also I strongly suggest that battery storage areas are a major fire and pollution risk, especially where they are surrounded by small villages and market towns.
