

I strongly object to the Rosefield Solar Farm proposal for the following reasons:

1. The impact on local residents who have chosen to live in a quiet, peaceful location will be completely obliterated.
 2. Both the building and operation will generate noise associated with the battery containers and their cooling systems, inverters and grid transformers. The potential for significant noise pollution especially at night would disturb village residents. The building phase of at least 18 months will have a detrimental effect on our health and well-being with literally hundreds of lorries and equipment being sent to the site.
 3. Perfectly good agricultural land being used for this project is 'criminal' both in the short term and the long term.
 4. Peoples' livelihoods are at stake – farmers who have leased land and grown an abundance of crops and cows grazing under perfect conditions, will be lost.
 5. We have endured the disruption of HS2, East West Rail, an incinerator, and possible very large prison – We have suffered enough!
 6. Our roads are wholly inadequate, myself and locals are inconvenienced by disruption from HS2 closures and the poorly maintained roads in and around our village. More HGVs are not only a noise nuisance but a very real safety concern.
 7. This will also compromise access to well used and loved footpaths/bridleways and rights of way
 8. This type of development should be built on industrial sites which have access, egress and are near main roads which do not impact local residents and businesses.
 9. Our countryside must be protected, now and for future generations. This is NOT the place for such a development
- In conclusion, I strongly object to the development on tenant farmland due to the very negative impact on lives and taking away natural resources, already used for our food production.
