

We would like to object to the Rosefield project that is currently under review.

We have been bombarded with excess traffic due to HS2 and East West rail causing our roads to become 'failed' roads due to heavy transport continually racing through tiny villages.

We live on the main road through Botolph Claydon and it may well be a 30 mph speed limit however this limit is exceeded from 6 am in the morning until after rush hour and once again from 4 pm. Heavy duty traffic and workers take no regard in observing rules.

If the application for the Solar project goes ahead then traffic will further be increased. Many of our houses were build early 1800's with no foundations and having heavy -load traffic pass by continually could de-stabilise our 'loved' properties.
