Whoever would consider and condone adding a solar farm to this particular area at this time?!

With many housing estates being built in and around Steeple Claydon, and the continuing bombardment of construction vehicles/work trucks/general plant dominating our environment over the past few years, it surely isn't viable.

The roads have been ruined and rarely repaired. How on earth can extra traffic be managed on these (often narrow) country roads?
