

I live in Quainton village which has and continues to be severely affected by construction traffic and local road closures. This is principally HS2, although other local construction such as housing development and East West rail also have a not insignificant impact. The main road through the village is already dangerous, particularly at school pick up and drop off times. The new local housing developments such as Berryfields, which do not have adequate primary school provision result in a far greater number of pupils at Quainton school being driven there. This creates double parking and gridlock in the village twice a day.

I have a small holding in the village and have horses. Which I need to ride through the village to access bridleways. 10 years ago this was a quiet rural village and riding across it was not an issue. With the number of HGVs we now have on the village roads, it is becoming dangerous and I hate to think of what it will be like with the additional traffic from the construction of the solar farm.

Please do not allow this to happen, Quainton's roads were never constructed for this level of heavy traffic and they cannot cope.
