

IMPORTANT AND RELEVANT ADDITION TO THE CUMULATIVE EFFECT OF ROSEFIELD AND ADJACENT SITES HAS JUST BEEN ANNOUNCED.

In point one of my relevant representation of 10 Dec 2025 with attachment I refer to the **cumulative effect** of Rosefield and the list of other solar, BESS and substation sites adjacent. I provided a sketch map in my attachment showing these sites and the nearby town of Winslow.

Please refer to my sketch map now and relate it to the following:

Since December, Buckinghamshire Council have published their draft Local Plan showing that 438.82 hectares of land at Winslow is allocated to 6,811 new houses with a further 4,775 beyond the plan period.

On Buck. Council website search 'Local Plan', select 'Local Plan for Bucks', scroll down for link to 'an interactive map' and relate this to my sketch map.

The allocated 438.82 hectares of new housing is adjacent to the cumulative sites comprising Rosefield and the other sites I have shown on my sketch map.

i.e. to the right of Tuckey Farm and above East-West Rail.

For reference, the allocated sites are: Winslow NW, Winslow NE, Land west of Furze Lane, Land south of Verney Road.

The CUMULATIVE EFFECT of housing, solar and BESS is now wholly inappropriate.

Since the Secretary of State for Net Zero, Ed Miliband, announced on 6th June 2025 (see BBC News report article c0j728gvp94o on BBC News website) that from 2027 all new housing is to have solar on the roof, **the additional housing in Winslow cannot be used as a justification for more solar farms.** The new housing will generate their own electricity.
