

I am [REDACTED] but wish to have recorded my strong objection to the proposed Rosefield further desecration of our already beleaguered corner of North Buckinghamshire. As a resident of Steeple Claydon I have already seen our environment trashed by HS2/EWR, loss of productive farmland, ancient woodland natural habitats as well as having our roads ripped to shreds and our daily lives ruined by noise and cavalier treatment by HS2 workforce - their managers being mostly to blame with promises of good communications and early warnings of road closures receiving only lip service. All this before we have seen a replacement tree planted or heard the "rumble" of a train. Added to this and responding to Government imperatives this village has had to endure the considerable noise and general disruption due to the building of three large housing estates in this less than huge village.
