

I wish to object in the strongest possible terms to the 2,100 acre development of a Solar Farm in the land between Calvert, Botolph and East Claydon.

I object on the basis of the following:

I understand that several farmers and business will lose their leased farmland and income.

The height, size and scale of this development in rural England on good quality farm land is not acceptable.

The area that is designated for the solar farm is in the close vicinity of the devastation and loss of land already caused by HS2 and this additional development is adding to the loss of rural landscape to local residents.

Travelling in the local vicinity is already severely impacted by HS2 road closures and further interruptions at the same time for both the public and emergency services is just not acceptable. The residents have had enough.
