

I am writing to strongly object to the proposed plans for rosefield solar farm.

Our local roads have already been completely destroyed by an overwhelming amount of HGV traffic from ongoing projects including HS2 and EWR. This is dangerous, as these large potholes often force drivers to swerve into oncoming lanes of traffic on narrow country roads. The increase in HGV traffic that would result from the solar farm being approved would be completely unsustainable for the local roads and would cause a significant negative impact to the local community.

A huge amount of the local countryside has already been decimated by HS2 and EWR. The proposed site of the solar farm is on some of the only remaining countryside that the local community has left. My family walks our dogs through those fields almost every day and we meet dozens of other local residents doing the same. Losing these beautiful fields would have a massive negative impact on the physical and mental health of a majority of the local community.

The noise and air pollution that would result from the construction of this project and its operation would also have a significant negative impact on the mental and physical health of local residents, who live in this area because they want to enjoy the peace and quiet of the countryside.

There would also be a hugely detrimental impact to the local wildlife, which has lost massive areas of habitat due to the aforementioned projects. We have seen deer and foxes walking through the villages where they never used to before, due to losing so much habitat. For a project which claims to be for eco-friendly energy production, the impact on the local wildlife would be immense.
