

I continue to object to this planning application on the grounds that:

My family and I and village community will be impacted by the traffic chaos during construction. (Road closures, narrow lanes, more HGV's etc)

2. Noise will disturb our daily lives during construction and beyond.

3. There will be a daily impact on how we are able to go about our lives such as doing the school run, travelling to work or working from home and disruptions to livelihoods, and the impact on local businesses that are important parts of our communities.
