

I remain completely opposed to the Rosefield Solar Farm development and believe that the planned development will have the following impact on me personally as a resident of Winslow:

- I live on [REDACTED] in Winslow and do not believe that the High Street (A413) or other local village roads will be able to cope with the proposed volume of construction traffic which will be necessary over the life of this project. This is heightened by the number of other projects already in progress including HS2 and EWR.
- I am also concerned about the increase in noise this traffic will bring and the affect this volume and noise of traffic will have on both my house and also Winslow as a whole. Winslow is a community, with children going to school both within the town but also on the high street by the train station and locals and visitors to the many businesses and shops on our high street. A significant volume of construction traffic coming through the town will likely affect the health of these businesses and shops on the High Street, reducing the facilities available to residents like myself, as well as risking the safety of residents with the heavy volume of construction traffic expected.
- I am also very concerned about the risk associated with the planned BESS facility particularly around fire safety and the effect on the local community including myself with the potential for fumes to affect Winslow and surrounding villages for weeks should the facility catch fire.
- Finally, I am concerned about the effect on our local countryside and environment from this facility including the removal of farmland which is critical for maintaining our local way of life and the areas identity.
