I work from home – the type of work I perform requires peace and quiet. The noise from the project will be extremely disruptive: noise from construction traffic, the close proximity of the construction activities such as the piling etc., and the nuisance noise once the installation is complete is of great concern to me. Also, the local road network will not cope with the amount of construction traffic associated with this proposed project as well as the ongoing HS2, Mega Prison, and the future BESS installation and proposed Claydon National Grid upgrade projects. I therefore request the member of the inspectorate to visit my home particularly during traffic rush-hours.

Another concern of mine is the impact on my health as a result of the increased pollution from the vehicles associated with the construction (i.e. vehicle fumes, increased 'dust' generation, significant construction particulates etc) as well as the high risk of noxious fumes as a result of fire from the BESS installation.
