

I am a resident of Botolph Claydon. I overlook the proposed location of the Rosefield Solar Farm. I am 100% AGAINST this proposal.

I am requesting a member from the inspectorate to visit my property so that they can understand the detrimental impact the Solar Energy Farm will have on the local environment, visual impact and detriment to my health and wellbeing.

The local road network will simply not be able to cope with the amount of construction traffic that will be associated with this project as well as the ongoing HS2, Mega Prison, and the future BESS installation and proposed Claydon National Grid upgrade projects.
