

I would like to request a site visit by the inspectorate to view the cottage I have lived in for the past 20 years. The address is [REDACTED].

The cottage is a 16th century brick and timber dwelling with an unspoiled view across the valley to Granborough, North Marston and Oving. The solar installation will blight the landscape and change the agricultural nature of the valley. The land has been used for grazing and cereal production for hundreds of years providing income for the landowners and employment for many people in the villages.

I am also concerned about the proximity to the proposed BESS and the noise generated. The additional traffic through the village during the installation phase will also cause an additional safety hazard as the roads were not designed to take large construction vehicles.
