RESPONSE TO EXQ1 IN RELATION TO THE ROSEFIELD SOLAR FARM PROJECT

The following table sets out the responses of Statkraft UK Limited (**Statkraft**) to the first written questions (**ExQ1**) from the Examining Authority (**ExA**) [[PD-010](#)] in relation to the Rosefield Solar Farm Project (the **Rosefield Project**). The ExA directed only question Q1.9.8 of ExQ1 to Statkraft, which is addressed in the table below.

The table further provides a response to the ExA's request for further information (**RFI**) issued to all parties on 10 April 2026 under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 [[PD-012](#)].

EXQ1 Q1.9.8	<p>Interface agreement</p> <p>The ExA notes the potential for an interface agreement between the 2 parties as identified in Stakraft UK Limited's written representation [REP1-134] and the applicant's Status of Negotiations with Statutory Undertakers [REP1-109]. The Status of Negotiations with statutory undertakers states that this would be in lieu of protective provisions.</p> <p>Does Statkraft UK Limited agree that such an agreement (if made) would replace the need for protective provisions? If not, why not? Should any provision be made in the draft Development Consent Order [REP1-008] to address concerns?</p>	<p>Interface Agreement</p> <p>The Applicant and Statkraft have commenced negotiation of an interface agreement.</p> <p>In the case that an interface agreement on terms satisfactory to Statkraft can be agreed before the end of the examination, it is Statkraft's position that this is capable of replacing the need for any protective provisions.</p> <p>However, in the case that the interface agreement cannot be agreed on satisfactory terms in a timeous manner, Statkraft reserves the right to make further representations to the ExA on this matter and may require provision to be made in the draft Development Consent Order to address Statkraft's concerns in such circumstances.</p> <p>Negotiation of the interface agreement between Statkraft and the Applicant is at an early stage. Statkraft will provide the ExA with an update on its position once negotiations have substantively progressed.</p> <p>Statkraft continues to endeavour to engage productively with the Applicant to agree on a suitable co-existence arrangement for Statkraft's East Claydon Greener Grid Park and the Rosefield Project.</p>
