

**National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc response to Examining Authority's  
Second Written Questions and Requests for Information (ExQ2) in relation to  
Rosefield Solar Farm Consent Order**

**1. Q 2.2.3 RESPONSE**

- 1.1 This response is submitted following the Examination Authority's second written questions and requests for information issued on 5 June 2026. This response is submitted on behalf of National Grid Electricity Transmission ("**NGET**") in respect of the application by Rosefield Energyfarm Limited ("**the Applicant**") for the Rosefield Solar Farm Development Consent Order ("**the Order**") to authorise the Rosefield Solar Farm Project ("**the Project**").
- 1.2 NGET agrees with the Applicant's position regarding the potential constraints of locating the BESS in fields E10 and E11. As has been stated by NGET in previous submissions, in accordance with its statutory and regulatory obligations NGET is implementing the Great Grid Upgrade, and the East Claydon Project comprises a key element of this. The Applicant and NGET are working together to ensure that the Project does not compromise NGET's ability to deliver proposed NGET East Claydon Project. As such, the Applicant has taken into account the prescribed easement distances either side of overhead line towers, and the lines that run between them. This is set out in NGET Technical Guidance Note TGN 287 Third-party guidance for working near National Grid Electricity Transmission equipment. The extent of those easements place constraints on locating the BESS in fields E10 and E11.

**Q 2.8.8 RESPONSE**

Optioneering of the East Claydon Project continues to evolve. At this time however it is not appropriate that any update is published as regards cumulative effects in the context of this Project because there is not sufficient level of detail to enable NGET to advance its procurement strategy nor its emission strategy. There is therefore no update to be made by NGET as regards the assumptions made by the Applicant regarding ES Chapter 17.
