

This application should not proceed, the impact on the local area will be immense and change the countryside forever.

This proposal is in the wrong location and will ruin the local area as detailed below.

There will be a significant loss of productive agricultural land .. it is essential to protect food production.

There will be a massive cumulative impact from Rosefield and other major projects, including traffic, HGVs, road closures and safety for walkers, cyclists and riders in my local area.

This will impact on wildlife, including Bechstein bats, as well as landscape, visual amenity and public rights of way.
