Deadline 7 Submissions

On behalf of Rosefield Energyfarm Limited (the 'Applicant'), we write to provide the Applicant's written submissions for Deadline 7 of the Rosefield Solar Farm Development Consent Order (DCO) Examination.

The Rule 17 letter [\[PD-019\]](#) confirmed that the Examining Authority (ExA) had made a procedural decision to vary the examination timetable to include a seventh Deadline to allow for comments on Deadline 6 submissions.

Final Document Versions

On review of the Deadline 6 submissions, the Applicant has resubmitted final versions of the following documents:

- Final Guide to the Application, including up to date schedule of documents to be certified;

Draft Development Consent Order

On review of the Deadline 6 submissions, the Applicant has re-provided: an email notification confirming that the final **Draft Development Consent Order (DCO) [EN010158/APP/3.1.10]** has successfully passed validation; a PDF version of the SI validation report and a clean standalone MS Word version of the **Draft DCO [EN010158/APP/3.1.10]** with no header or footer.

Table 1 (**Appendix 1**) comprises the application documents for which updated versions are being submitted and summarises the reasons why each document has been updated. Each updated document has been submitted with both clean and tracked change versions to aid the Examining Authority (the 'ExA') in identifying the changes. The exceptions to this are where Figures have been updated and a Revisions Schedule has instead been provided for clarity.
