Dear Sir or Madam,

We are instructed by National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc ("NGET") in relation to the application made by One Earth Solar Limited ("the Applicant") for a Development Consent Order (the "Order") to authorise the One Earth Solar Project (the "Project"). This response to the Examination Authority's Request for Information dated 1 May 2026 is submitted on behalf of NGET.

NGET has now reached agreement with the Applicant in respect of the Protective Provisions, and it is NGET's understanding that the Applicant has submitted the settled form of Protective Provisions with the Secretary of State to be included within the Order. NGET has also agreed commercial terms documented in a separate agreement with the Applicant, which has not yet been completed.
