Good afternoon,

Thank you for your request for information letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026 seeking comments from Nottinghamshire County Council (NCC) on the proposed wording for Requirement 7 and 22 of the draft DCO in respect of hydrology.

NCC does not object to the further amendments being proposed to the wording of Requirements 7 and 22 which appears to provide greater clarity on the scope of the battery safety management plan and the flood risk mitigation to be submitted post consent and reduce flexibility for deviation from the outline documentation submitted at examination. However, the Environment Agency (EA) is the body that is responsible for managing flood risk associated with the River Trent and the EA will also be responsible for providing advice to the local authority on the discharge of Requirement 22. Therefore, NCC would ask that the Secretary of State fully takes into account the response of the EA to these amendments.

NCC has also been recently contacted by Save Our Heritage Villages, the group representing North and South Clifton residents, who remain greatly concerned at the uncertainty remaining in terms of the impact of this development on flood risk due to the level of detail that remains to be determined post consent. NCC would wish to highlight the representations which have been made by local residents and other interested parties on the issue of flood risk throughout the examination and requests assurance that these are given full consideration in the written report and determination of the application.
