

Located on the edge of Norwell, this view is relatively open along the road and over the roadside hedges to the north and west and contained by trees and buildings within the village in other directions. There are nearby homes and large farm buildings seen looking to the north and west set among fields and backed by gently rising ground which forms the skyline. Occasional pylons and wind turbines are also seen along the skyline.

## Predicted Changes to Views

During constructions and early operation, solar arrays would be seen above and through the nearby sparse hedge which forms the skyline to the north beyond the farm buildings. Once this hedge is mature the Development would be screened from view.


