sorry so late with the walk for tomorrow

Start North street Sturton le Steeple.

Park here and walk past the houses last is a bungalow followed by Farm buildings. The landowner has applied to build 9 houses. Why 9? because if there are 10 he has to build an affordable house.

Continue until you get to a waste bin and a wooden bridge. Cross the bridge and through the gate.

Follow the field round the edge and cross a field.

Continue across the field and cross the quarry road and go through the gate.

These field I believe will be battery packs for the gas station and the grid have being on them with large vehicle maintaining the pylons. It is being surveyed by someone for wildlife I think newts. You may see the black mats which have been put down. This used to be a favourite place for deer.

Go up the next set of steps and you will enter another field. This was surveyed and nearly killed a hare lying in the grass were they baby's. They didn't seem to care.

Follow the footpath and you will come to a gap and a gate in the hedge. Go through this and cross the quarry road again.

Go across the field and turn left.

You will see some gates again over the quarry road go through them and cross the bridge at the other side.

To the left of the bridge the landowners agent removed a footpath sign. My friend was walking her dog and saw this.

[REDACTED] Until you reach the catchment drain at the bottom. You will pass the cabins of the quarry.

Turn right and follow it along at the end turn right. If you look at the field to you left on the corner this is a silt pond for the quarry. It has flooded for years.

Continue up this road until you get to the junction.

You can go right across cross common and back to north street. Walk across it and turn left and keep walking you will find your car.

Or

Turn left at the junction. Then right onto the road and keep walking Just before the bridge there is a gate on your left. Go through this gate to Fenton. You will be following the cable route of RES.

At the next gate turn right and follow the road to the main road.

At the junction turn left and cross the road you will see a track with a gate. Go to the left of

the gate and follow the track. It will come to a train track bridge. Go passed this and you will come to a track on your left.

Follow this round you will pass a crossing over the train tracks. This is a walk for another day. Keep going straight forward and you will come to Freemans lane. Walk to the end and turn left. You will be on the main road.

Continue on the path and you will come to the top of North Street where your car will be parked. Have another couple which you might like if you come back another time.
