

1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 This document has been prepared to provide the Examining Authority ('ExA') with the latest position on Statements of Common Ground ('SoCG') between Steeple Solar Farm Limited (the 'Applicant') and statutory consultees, statutory undertakers and other Interested Parties (the 'parties') in relation to the Steeple Renewables Project (the 'Proposed Development').
- 1.1.2 This document provides a position on the commonality on specific points between SoCG's at Deadline 1 (being 25 November 2025).
- 1.1.3 The Applicant will, for each deadline during the course of the Examination, update this Statement as a record of the progress being made with the various parties. When sufficient progress has been made on agreements between the parties, this document will also discuss those areas of commonality between parties to enable the efficient resolution and focusing in on the remaining issues.

1.2 Structure of this Document

3 Commonality

3.1 Structure of the SoCGs
